

Full job description

PURPOSE: The Camp Cook is responsible for the overall culinary experience for all campers and staff when Summer Camp is in session.

APPOINTED BY: The Camp Hope Board of Management

ACCOUNTABLE TO: The Camp Director, and the Board of Management in absence of the Camp Director

PERSONAL AND PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS: Knowledge, skills, and experience should be appropriate for a professional safely serving food in a commercial kitchen. The Camp Cook should obtain a ServSafe Food Handler Certification, and this can be obtained after a position has been offered. A well-qualified candidate will possess qualities which exhibit a personal commitment to Christian faith and life and a general acquaintance with and appreciation for the Moravian Church. Applicants need not be a member of a Moravian congregation, but Moravians are especially encouraged to apply.

Applicants should have at least 1 year of prior commercial kitchen experience, or 2 examples of prior seasonal commercial kitchen experience. Culinary experience commensurate with the above will be considered.

COMPENSATION: Starting Salary \$16-17 based on experience

TIME OFF: With approval from the Camp Board, Paid Time Off is not available with seasonal positions

RESPONSIBILITIES: The Camp Cook is responsible for oversight of the Kitchen during the Summer season and ultimately is responsible for kitchen safety, meal preparation, and safe food handling for campers and staff. The Camp Cook has responsibility for the inventory needs of the kitchen. The Camp Cook works collaboratively with other Camp staff to facilitate meals and the daily course of all kitchen operations. Work hours are fixed when Summer Camp is in season: Sunday dinner through Saturday breakfast weekly. Separate Cook quarters are provided on the Camp grounds when camp is in session.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Specific tasks include but are not limited to:

- Responsible for cooking all meals and snacks during the Summer camp season
- Reports to the Camp Director
- Works with assigned Summer camp staff, as assigned by the Summer Camp manager, to facilitate meal preparation, kitchen work, and clean-up.

· Plans menus and provides food ordering requests to the Camp Director prior to each Summer Camp weekly session.

· Prepares weekly report up to the Camp Director at the end of every Summer Camp weekly session.
